DIRECTOR'S CORNER

Table Etiquette

- Cards cannot be taken out of the board until there are three players present at the table **not before**.
- Dummy must not touch a card until the declarer has called for a card. HANDS OFF DUMMY!
- Once a card has been nominated from dummy, it must be played.
- Opening lead is to be placed face down on the table until partner indicates for it to be turned over.

Don't forget, our Directors are here to assist players and they enjoy being able to solve any issues that arise during play. Make sure you call the Director because they are the ones with detailed knowledge and they **LOVE** a challenge.
